Dear Church:

The Southern Baptists of Texas Convention staff prays God's blessings upon you during this season of celebrating the birth of Christ. Today 2,684 churches partner in missions and ministry in Texas and around the world through the SBTC. Together we are reaching Texas and impacting the world.

Ministry highlights this year include:

- Disaster Relief ministry included 29,730 volunteer hours on 21 responses in Texas and 4 out of state responses, served 214,823 meals, 7,522 spiritual contacts and saw 617 professions of faith
- Student camps had 2,751 in attendance with 318 first time professions of faith and 56 called to ministry
- Over 50 churches participated in revitalization events & training
- 1,400 received encouragement and training at 2021 Empower Conference/ Over 1,000 trained at regional Knowing and Sharing Your Faith conferences/ Over 800 lay leaders and pastors trained through the Capacitate (Equipping) regional conferences/ 1400 participated in the Equip Conference
- Supported over 3,500 missionaries around the world through the IMB
- Supported church planting and other mission efforts in North America through NAMB
- Funded a portion of educational costs for students at six SBC seminaries

All this and much more are possible because of the Cooperative Program (CP) giving of churches across the state. CP funds are undesignated gifts through your state convention which are applied to the adopted budget. Fifty-five percent of all CP gifts go to the Southern Baptist Convention for missions and ministry in North America and around the world. The 45 percent invested in Texas is paying eternal dividends.

Regarding 2021 year-end giving, gifts postmarked by December 31, 2021, and received by January 7, 2022, will apply to the 2021 giving year. Gifts postmarked after December 31, or received after January 7, will be applied to the 2022 giving year.

Thank you for your ministry partnership through the Cooperative Program and the Southern Baptists of Texas Convention. We pray God's blessings on you in the New Year.

"Houston, We Have a Problem!"



1 Corinthians 10 ¹Now I do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud, all passed through the sea, ²and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. ³They all ate the same spiritual food, ⁴and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual rock that followed them, and that rock was Christ. ⁵Nevertheless God was not pleased with most of them, since they were struck down in the wilderness. ⁶Now these things took place as examples for us, so that we will not desire evil things as they did. ⁷Don't become idolaters as some of them were; as it is written, The people sat down to eat and drink, and got up to party. ⁸Let us not commit sexual immorality as some of them did, and in a single day twenty-three thousand people died. ⁹Let us not test Christ as some of them did and were destroyed by snakes. ¹⁰And don't grumble as some of them did, and were killed by the destroyer. ¹¹These things happened to them as examples, and they were written for our instruction, on whom the ends of the ages have come. ¹²So, whoever thinks he stands must be careful not to fall. ¹³No temptation has come upon you except what is common to humanity. But God is faithful; he will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation he will also provide the way out so that you may be able to bear it. ¹⁴So then, my dear friends, flee from idolatry."
